2. Hebrews 12:28-29 reads "Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire."
 - Do you believe God's Kingdom cannot be shaken? Why or why not?
 - What does "God is a consuming fire" mean?

3. When it comes to the "why" of worship, John 3:16 was noted: "For God so loved the world that He gave us His only Son that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life!"
 - What is the best human illustration you can share about agape love (unconditional love)?
 - Why is the "cross of Jesus Christ" the center of worship?
